Special professional qualification

In my graduate education at the University of Vienna, I was trained in theoretical linguistics with an emphasis on syntactic theory as well as interface-issues (syntax-morphology, syntax-semantics, and syntax-pragmatics). At this time my primary language focus was on Germanic. After completing my graduate work and a visit at the University of California at Southern California I came to the University of British Columbia in 1996 as a postdoctoral researcher. Here I expanded my language specialization to include Upriver Halkomelem (a local First Nations language). This meant breaking into research areas that were completely new to me: I had never done linguistic fieldwork and I had never worked on a non-Indo-European language. These areas, and more recently also the study of Blackfoot (Algonquian) and Ktunaxa (language isolate), are the ones that still define my research and teaching agenda. As such I am actively contributing to one of our department's core strength: the integration of linguistic fieldwork and theoretical linguistics.
